Healthy Cooking - Learn healthy cooking methods.



Free Tax Help!

Now through April 11, 2012, AARP Tax-Aide volunteers will be available

each Wednesday afternoon from 12:30 to 4:30 p.m. at the Desert Foothills Library. They will help taxpayers prepare and file their personal federal and Arizona income tax returns.

Please bring the following with you when you come:

- Current year's tax forms and preparation booklet
- Copy of last year's income tax return(s)
- W-2 forms from each employer
- Unemployment compensation statements
- SSA-1099 form if you were paid Social Security benefits

- All 1099 forms (1099-INT, 1099-DIV, 1099-B, etc.) showing interest and/or dividends and documentation showing original purchase price of sold assets
- 1099-MISC showing any miscellaneous income
- 1099-R form if you received a pension or annuity
- All forms indicating federal income tax paid
- Dependent care provider information (name, employer ID, Social Security number)
- All receipts or canceled checks if itemizing deductions
- Social Security cards or other official documentation for yourself and all dependents.
