- Delivered Mobile Meals on a day that registered 115 degrees!
- Took on extra services to cover for volunteers away for the summer
- Changed one more light bulb on an 18 foot ceiling
- Spent 6 hours on the van taking neighbors to Walmart when they could have been home in the pool

Here's how it works. Buy a \$20 gift card and when used, reload it, then use the card as you would use a debit card. Foothills Caring Corps receives 6% of every dollar you load onto your

card. The card can be reloaded as often as you need and can be reloaded from \$20 up to \$500 at a time. You simply ask for the reload at the check-out line.
