

Fall Prevention Seminar

On September 25, in recognition of Fall Prevention Week, the Foothills Caring Corps



hosted a seminar on preventing falls for our Neighbors, Volunteers and the general public. Fred Aboulhosn of Carefree Physical Therapy gave a talk about what factors are most likely to cause a fall, what steps can be taken to prevent falls, and the importance of maintaining balance and strength as people get older. Michelle Barth of Scottsdale Healthcare led the group through a set of exercises that will help to maintain strength in the legs and ankles – so important in preventing falls. Shadman Hosseini of Walgreen's Pharmacy, spoke to the group about medications that can cause dizziness and balance problems and answered questions about their prescriptions. It was a very informative seminar and we would like to thank all who participated in this very important effort of preventing falls.

Stop by the Caring Corps office and pick up a brochure with tips and resources on steps that can be taken to prevent falls, exercising to maintain strength, the importance of using a walker or cane if needed, and safety measures that can be taken around the home.
