### *New Program at FCC*

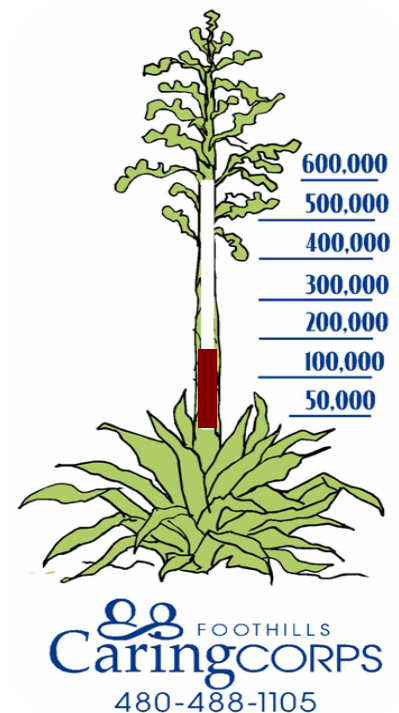
#### *Medical Loan Closet*
