your shoes or your pants or your shirt?



Beware of "Grandparent" Scam

Seniors should be cout. be their grandchild and requests money for an urgent situation. The Attorney General's Office has received information that the "grandparent scam" is in Arizona.

> In this scam, the fraud artist calls an elderly person and poses as their grandchild. The caller may say something like, "Grandma, I am so glad I reached you" or "Grandpa, it's me, your favorite grandchild calling." The caller waits for the grandparent to say something like, "Jimmy, is that you?" The caller will agree and state that he or she has

either been in a bad accident or is in some type of trouble and needs money immediately. The caller then asks that the money be sent via money order or through a wire service such as MoneyGram or Western Union.

Here are some tips to remember to avoid falling for this type of scam:

- Verify your family member's whereabouts by directly calling another family member or the grandchild directly with the number you are familiar with. Do not call the caller with the phone number that person provided.
- Don't "fill in the blanks" for the caller. If the caller says, "This is your favorite grandson," ask "Which one?"


