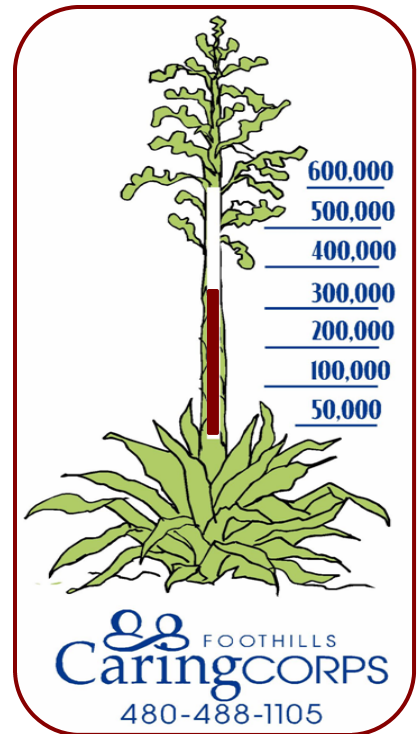

Life Insurance



People own all kinds of life insurance: term policies, whole life policies, and accidental death and dismemberment policies to name a few. Life insurance is often an easy way to ensure that funds are available at your death. You might have owned the policy for so long that you no longer make any premium payments or your premium payments might be fairly small if you own a term policy.

A term policy is a policy that is only in force for a certain period of time. At the end of that period of time, if you were to pass away, there would be no benefit for the beneficiaries named in the policy. Term policies do not have any cash value—i.e. you cannot borrow money or “cash out” the policy during your lifetime. One of the benefits of a term policy is that the cost is usually much lower than a whole life policy.

A whole life policy, as its name suggests, is available for your whole entire life! When you die, so long as you have continued to make your premium payments, the policy will pay out to your named beneficiaries. These policies also, typically, have some cash value. That is, you could request that the policy be terminated and that the insurance company send you a check for the cash value. You might also be able to take a loan against that same cash value.

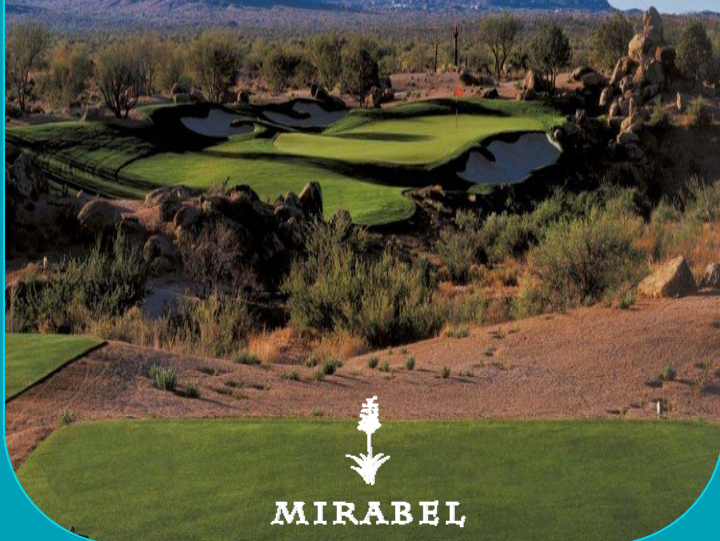
If you own life insurance, you can name the Caring Corps as a beneficiary, even as a piece of the policy. For example, you could specify that the Foothills Caring Corps receives 10% of the policy and then your other heirs split the remainder. You can name FCC to be a beneficiary of any portion of the death benefit. There is no complicated administration for this portion at your death. All you need to do is let the Caring Corps know that it has been named as the beneficiary and let your Trustee or Executor know to inform us of your passing. This is a wonderful and simple way for us to honor your memory and for you to help ensure that FCC is available for future generations of Neighbors in need.
