

# David Schwan Foothills Caring Corps 2016 Humanitarian

A native of York, Pennsylvania, David graduated from Drexel Institute of Technology, and received an MBA from New York University. His 30 year career was with Ford Motor Company in Grosse Pointe, Michigan.

In 2001 David and his wife Binka retired and moved to Carefree with the intent to become active in their new community by giving back. David



Continuing his community work David's involvement with the Town of Carefree led to an appointment with the Planning and Zoning Commission. David was then appointed to the Town Council in 2005 and was elected for a full term in 2007. In 2009 he was appointed Mayor by the Town Council and was then elected again in 2011 and 2013. David left office in 2014 due to his ALS diagnosis.

David is proud of what he helped create and preserve for Carefree in the beautiful downtown Gardens with the amazing support of Mark & Juanita Wdowlak. He also steered through the first piece of desert land in Carefree to be held in perpetuity and made way for Carefree and Cave Creek to combine their court systems to save money for both towns.

## Update...Protecting Americans Tax Hikes Act (PATH)

The Charitable IRA Rollover is now a permanent tax law.

One of the many provisions made permanent by the new law (PATH), Protecting Americans from Tax Hikes Act of 2015 (signed by President

Obama last year) was the <u>Charitable IRA Rollover</u>. This law allows donors age 70 ½ or older to transfer funds from their IRA directly to a charity, such as to the Foothills Caring Corps, without triggering federal income taxes on those funds. The effect of this provision is that it may lower one's adjusted gross income reportable on the tax return. This also allows donors to get the tax benefit of a charitable contribution even if they don't itemize their deductions. The Charitable IRA Rollover is limited to \$100,000. Also, an IRA rollover gift to a donor-advised funding or supporting organization is not allowed, only gifts to 501(c)3 public charities.
