Featured this month is Foothills Caring Corps Mobile Meals Program



In 1992 a small group of community volunteers organized the Meals on Wheels Program. Under the umbrella of Foothills Community Foundation, in 2004 the Caring Corps was asked to take over responsibility for the program and it was renamed the Mobile Meals Program. The Mobile Meals program serves the communities of Carefree, Cave Creek, North Scottsdale and North Phoenix.

Our Neighbors receiving meals are adults over age 65 or adults over 18 with a disabling condition. Mobile Meals are available to any member of the community that meets the eligibility requirements. A hot, nutritious noon time meal is delivered

Monday-Friday between 11:30 and 1:00 pm with 3 meals delivered on Fridays for those needing 7 meals per week. Last year, 65 Mobile Meal volunteers delivered over 7,663 meals to more than 50 Neighbors. For more information regarding eligibility call 480.488.1105.

The Caring Corps delivery area is north of Bell Rd/Frank Lloyd Wright to Tonto Hills, east to Rio Verde, west to I-17. Each day 8-10 volunteers meet at Honor Health Thompson Peak Café to pick up the 50 or more meals for delivery on the five different routes. The hot entrees vary from chicken, beef, pork, fish or vegetarian along with a starch and a vegetable. Also included are milk, bread, salad and dessert. Our meals meet dietary guidelines for the aging population, and are low in salt and sugar.



With each delivery, the volunteer visits with the Neighbor and checks on how they are doing. This may be the only interaction the Neighbor will have for the day. Volunteer drivers get to know the Neighbors on their route and it is a wonderfully rewarding experience.

Volunteers are the lifeline of the Mobile Meals Program. They provide a human response that is so meaningful to the homebound person. Whether you have a lot of time or a little, please consider volunteering for Mobile Meals! Our volunteer orientations are the second Thursday of each month from 9-11am.



"It's important to recognize people and organizations in this state, country, and world who are truly making a difference in this journey we call life. I would like to say how much I appreciate and love the people who make up the Foothills Caring Corps. If it wasn't for all of the caring volunteers who work together as a team, my Father would not be able to remain in his home (as he has dementia and is a shut in). If he didn't get the one hot, wholesome meal a day delivered by the AWESOME volunteers and the weekly visit from his wonderful volunteer friend his life would not be as healthy. Due to the rock solid dependability of the FCC staff my Dad

As a Small Business Owner, How Can I Help?

Small business owners often look for opportunities to get involved in their communities, and supporting local charities can be a great way to do it. Here are some potential approaches:

Monetary donations. Always appreciated, a simple gift of cash is generally tax deductible if made to a qualified organization. Foothills Caring Corps is a Qualifying Charitable Organization.

Inventory donations. In general, a tax deduction will be available for the inventory's cost. However, a regular C corporation that contributes inventory for use in aiding the ill, needy or infants may receive an enhanced deduction.

Volunteering. Although you can't deduct the value of donated services, related out-of-pocket expenses are potentially deductible. Or consider giving employees a limited amount of paid time off to volunteer.

Sponsorships. Sponsoring a charity event offers public recognition of the company's charitable activities. This can help it attract new customers and enhance its reputation. Potential tax deductions depend on the specifics.
