## **Foothills Caring Corps Purchases New Building to Support Growing Community Needs**

### **The Next Chapter of Caring**

CAREFREE, AZ (June 2026) Foothills Caring Corps has purchased a new facility at **6070 E. Cave Creek Road in Cave Creek**, marking a significant milestone in the organization's ongoing commitment to meeting community needs.

The purchase comes amid sustained growth in both demand for services and the complexity of support required.

For more than 25 years, Caring Corps has provided essential services, including transportation to medical appointments, meal delivery, mobility equipment lending, home maintenance assistance, social connection programs, and most recently, dementia and memory-focused programming. The organization helps seniors and adults with disabilities remain independent, connected, and safe at home.

"As our community continues to age, more families are turning to Caring Corps for support," said Brent Downs, Executive Director of Foothills Caring Corps. "This expansion is not simply about a building; it is about ensuring we have the space, capacity, and operational efficiency to meet growing needs today while preparing thoughtfully for the future."

The organization officially closed on the property on June 1, 2026. The purchase follows years of growth that increasingly strained the capacity of its current facility. Rising lease costs also prompted organizational leaders to pursue a long-term solution that would offer greater stability and sustainability.

The new location will allow Foothills Caring Corps to:

- Coordinate volunteers and services more effectively
- Improve logistics for transportation, meal delivery, and mobility equipment lending
- Provide dedicated space for volunteer training, community collaboration, and partner meetings
- Strengthen the operational infrastructure that supports every Caring Corps program
- *Thoughtfully* expand the organization to address emerging community needs, including memory programming, caregiver support, and additional opportunities for social connection



The larger facility will also help deepen volunteer engagement and expand collaboration with local organizations, businesses, and community leaders. The move reflects a commitment to **responsible growth** and **long-term community impact**.

"This investment is ultimately about people," Downs said. "It's about our Neighbors, caregivers, volunteers, and families. We want to ensure that our community can continue aging with dignity, independence, and connection, and that Caring Corps remains prepared to serve future generations as those needs continue to grow."
